<u>Secretary Report – Pat Engstrom (W1PGE)</u>

• Approve the minutes of the previous Board meeting – Minutes were approved as submitted.

<u>Treasurer Report – Don (KE0EE)</u>

• Approve Treasurer Report. Detailed report is in Appendix A. Treasurer's Report was approved as submitted.

Don presented a short paper on using \$2000 from our savings account to invest in some ETF stock companies. The sense of the Board was investing the Club's funds in the stock market has too much risk for a not-for-profit organization. Kat agreed to help Don research money market, CD's or bond funds that offer low risk as possible vehicles for investing the Club's funds.
