New Business

Raffle Proposal. Don proposed the Club conduct a raffle as a Club fund raiser. There was discussion on the proposal and Dick Paige offered to investigate the idea and bring it back to the Board. Don went to a lot or work suggesting several different lists of prizes, his proposal is detailed below:

This proposal is to create a high value Ham Radio Raffle. The period will be from February 1, 2021 and conclude 6 months later.

The grand prize will be a HF / 50Mhz high Performance Radio. The estimated value is \$3,600 to \$1800 and \$400+ in other prizes. The price for each ticket will be \$15 with a maximum of 400 or 500 tickets. The breakeven point is 250 /200 tickets. Tickets will be printed before the raffle is started.

Advertisements would be sent to all Colorado Clubs. Members would be able to sell or purchase tickets. A new PayPal account would be created for only raffles. Payment for tickets can be by cash, check or PayPal. Each person purchasing a ticket will be sent/given a ticket(s) and some other low value item (<\$2 incl postage) with LARC information.
