<u> Technical Chair report – Ron Schwartz (K2RAS)</u>

Ron has developed a LARC Radio Communication Plan as part of his Emergency Exercises he is conducting in preparation for support for a local emergency.

Ron has also developed a plan for evolution and growth of the LARC Network. In support of that evolution, Ron requested the following items to be purchased that will facilitate microwave communications while in the field. The Board approved that purchase.

1. MFJ-4416C Battery Booster for GOBOX. This will increase the voltage from the LiFePO4 battery from 12.5V to 13.8V (required to transmit at 100W on the ICOM 7300). \$190

2. (2) Blackmore portable tripods to support a microwave dish (\$34 each)

3. (2) Ubiquity microwave dishes for portable operation (\$75 each)

4. Microtek Router to create portable IP network (\$53)

5. (2) Tycon Systems 12-24V PoE Inserter (\$45 each)
