Longmont Amateur Radio Club - Weekly Net Script

First you must **check** that the repeater is not in use. If it is, politely request use of the repeater for the net.

Remember to allow time for stations to break in during the squelch tail at the end of each transmission. Also, you must identify with your call sign every 10 minutes per FCC.

"This is (Your Call), (Your Name), calling the Longmont Amateur Radio Club weekly net.

"This is an informal net on topics of interest to LARC members and the Amateur Radio community in this area. It is held each Thursday at 8pm. All amateurs are welcome to participate.

"We are using the club's VHF repeater at 147.270 Mhz, with a (+) offset and a 100 Hz PL tone, and our UHF repeater at 448.800 Mhz with a (-) offset and an 88.5 Hz PL tone.

"Are there any stations with special announcements for the net? Please call now.

Note: acknowledge callsigns and names and continue

"When you check into this net, please state your call sign, and a second time again phonetically, your name, and location.

Check-ins for the LARC weekly net, all suffixes Alpha thru Echo. Please call now, Repeat with each group

... Alpha thru Juliet ~ Alpha thru Oscar ~ Alpha thru Tango ~ Alpha thru Zulu

(Write down call signs/names. Pause the check-ins as necessary, to ask for repeats, or to resolve double transmissions).

"We will now move to announcements. (Ask the first announcement station to proceed, when he/she is finished, go to the next station and repeat).

"We will now move to the general portion of the net, and hear from each station. (Call each station one by one in check-in order, including those who had announcements).

Conduct the net with your own style – you might pose a question prior to announcements, or ask how everyone is doing.

"We are almost done with the net tonight. Are there any late check-ins, comments or questions before we close the net? (*Allow time for responses*).

"This net occurs each Thursday evening at 8 PM local time. The club meets in a general meeting on the third Wednesday each month in the Clover Building at the Boulder County Fairgrounds in Longmont.

We have a new format for our meetings now: The doors will open at 6:30 for Social Time before the meeting starts at 7:00 pm. After a short business meeting, including introductions, updates from Board members and the evening's presentation, we typically have Show and Tell and/or more socializing at 8:00.
